Chair's Report:

- 1) Pizza
 - o No more late orders for pizza
 - o New process to help automate orders teachers' names on forms and orders tracked on an excel spreadsheet
 - o Continued confusion among families about using school cash on line to pay for orders
 - Discussion about possibility of offering an alternative to pizza lunches. Some parents in attendance suggested
 the possibility of baking and selling pies at lunch time. Naoko to collaborate with interested parents on
 starting this initiative off in the coming months
- 2) Teacher Appreciation Breakfast
 - October 11th is a PD day.
 - o Food to be dropped off at school at 7:45
 - o Susan/ Jess will look after contacting Starbucks for a donation of coffee
- 3) Ways to Engage more families
 - o Providing English and Arabic translation at school council meetings

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Principal's Report

- 1) Week 3 of school and things are off to a great start: Bus routes are great. Many students are participating in breakfast club. Cross country running has started.
- 2) EQAO test results (grade 6 students) have improved greatly from last year
- 3) Caroline will provide more information at the October meeting about ways to support families with math activities at home
- 4) Meet the teacher night is September 26th (later changed to October 10th). School council will have information table set up for families to learn about what council does.
- 5) Due to low class sizes, there is going to be some shifting of class compositions at the school. One kindergarten class will be lost thereby turning the current 3 class set up into 2. Change will take place on September 30th. This will also result in some staff changes. Jessica to follow up with the school trustee and board superintendent on concerns about these changes.

Teacher requests

In previous years, school council has financially supported 3 school-wide activities at Blossom Park. Teachers are asking for funds to do them again

- 1) Trip to Ottawa 67s game for the jr & intermediate students
 - Request to council to pay \$2-\$3/ ticket for about 150 students = \$450
- 2) Love to Groove Workshop activity for all students K 8
 - School pays \$1100 (1/2 of cost), grant from school board covers about ¼ of cost. Request to council to pay about \$900
- 3) Mental Health Initiative through school board Wellness Week.

Request to school council to provide \$1000 to help fund the following activities

- Yoga, walking
- Smoothies as prepared by BIP class
- Mindfulness activities & art
- Meditation
- Acts of kindness
